First Study Visit

When:

During your research visit.

What to expect:

A study coordinator at the site will help you decide if the study is right for you.

If you join the study, you will:

- Answer some questions about yourself.
- Receive a medical examination.
- Review your medical history and current care plan.
- Complete brain MRI.
- Complete blood draw.
- Complete memory and thinking testing.



Two More Visits over the next 3 years

When:

Every 12 to 18 months after your first visit.

What to expect:

Repeat the same procedure during two more visits.

After you finish the study:

You will continue participating in research at your local center, if you wish.
